

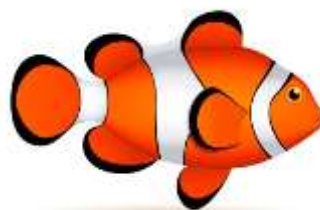
## Mission/Outreach
